

Writing With Results workshops have totally changed my story writing approach with my students. The students have shown a very high degree of success because lessons have been divided into several manageable segments, leading to one complete story in the end. Story patterns include Copycat, Switch, Transformation, Circle and others. Students are guided how to create a setting, introduce story figures, develop a plot or multiple plots with a specific structure, make a resolution to the story and SHOW (using descriptive verbs from banks) the story as a motion picture and make it come alive for the reader. Students have a great sense of pride with the stories that they write. Specific lessons are directly taught in other subjects and now I am able to do the same with respect to writing stories. Parents have been amazed with the strategies that I have shared with them and their children.
